Spring Election to be held on April 3, 2018


The Spring Election will be held on April 3, 2018. Contests on the ballot include Justice of the Wisconsin Supreme Court, Walworth County Board of Supervisors - District #5, Village Board of Trustees, Delavan-Darien School Board Members, Delavan-Darien School District Referendum. and a Statewide Referendum.

Village residents will vote at Village Hall in the Board Room, and the polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Remember to bring your photo identification card to vote. New Village residents or those who have changed their name or moved since the last election may register to vote on Election Day and will need to bring a valid form of proof of residence to do so. Public Works Department News

Brush Collection: Village curbside collection of brush takes place on Tuesdays. Please stack brush with the cut ends facing the street in small piles not more than two feet in height, spread out from one another so they do not become tangled. Brush should be longer than 4 feet in length but no larger than 6 inches in diameter. If you can drag the brush to the road, Public Works staff can put it in the chipper. Thank you for your cooperation!

Compost Site: Grass clippings, leaves, brush, and other organic yard waste may be deposited at the Village's compost site located at 339 Oak Street (Water Tower #1). This facility is for Village residents only. The site is open on weekdays from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and on Saturdays from 7:00 a.m. until noon. Please do not deposit non-compostable materials such as tree stumps, concrete, treated lumber, or trash/debris. The mulch located at this site is available for Village residents to use on their private property.
