Updates from May 21st Village Board Meeting

- The Village President issued an Official Proclamation recognizing Emergency Medical Services Week and honoring all of the dedicated Darien Fire and EMS volunteers who serve our community. EMS Week was May 20th through May 26th but can be celebrated all year by thanking these hard-working volunteers! - The Village Board approved the purchase of two solar-powered pedestrian-actuated rectangular rapid-flashing beacons to be installed this fall at the Highway 14 crosswalk just south of Madison Street.
- The Village Board discussed the possibility of detaching the Village from the Delavan-Darien School District. No formal action was taken.
- The Village Board appointed Darien resident and business owner Mark Stiles to the office of Darien Municipal Court Judge for the remainder of the current term (June 1, 2018 through April 30, 2019). The office was vacated by Judge Roger Farnsworth due to a change in residency. **Thank you to Roger for your 15 years of dedicated service to the Village and its residents!**

Darien Waterworks and Sewer System Annual Drinking Water Quality Report Available

2018 Weed Notice

Please note that noxious weeds are prohibited in the Village and that all grass and other vegetation must remain below twelve (12) inches in height. If grasses and/or weeds grow taller than 12 inches in height, the Village may cause them to be cut and/or removed at the expense of the property owner. Please do your part in keeping Darien beautiful by removing noxious weeds and maintaining your lawns.



Hydrant Flushing Notice

The Darien Water Utility will be flushing hydrants in June to reduce and remove the accumulation of rust and iron in the Village's water main distribution system. The flushing may cause discolored water in your system. This discolored water is bacteriologically safe and will not harm you. Grass clippings, leaves, brush, and other organic yard waste may be deposited at the Village's compost site located at 339 Oak Street (Water Tower #1). This facility is for Village residents only. The site is open on weekdays from 7:00 am to 3:30 pm and on Saturdays from 7:00 am until noon. Please do not deposit non-compostable materials such as tree stumps, concrete, treated lumber, or trash/debris. The mulch located at this site is available for Village residents to use on their private property.

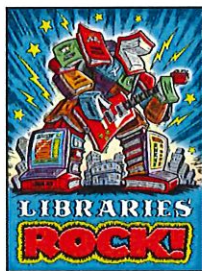
DON'T FORGET ABOUT OUR TERRIFIC TUESDAY ACTIVITIES!

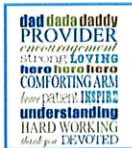
