Water Rate Increase Effective on July 19, 2018

The Darien Water Works and Sewer System filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW) to increase water rates. A public hearing was held on May 23rd, and the PSCW issued the finalized rates which will be effective on July 19, 2018. Meters will be read on or about August 20th, and utility bills with the new rates will be mailed to customers on August 31st. The first utility bills with the new water rates will be due on September 20th. The following tables show the new rates and the impact on average water bills.

Offensive Environmental Odor Update

At the June 18th Village Board meeting, the Board approved a letter to be provided to the Walworth County Zoning Agency (CZA) relating to the offensive environmental odors in the Darien Community. The letter requests that the CZA not approve any new land use applications or amendments to existing land use applications for Birds Eye Foods or Walter and Son Waste Hauling until the odor issues have been resolved. The letter also requests that the CZA allow public hearings for these applications so that community members may ask questions and voice concerns. The CZA met on June 21st and requested that representatives from Birds Eye Foods attend the July meeting to report on progress relating to odor mitigation.

Second Installment of Taxes Due to COUNTY on July 31, 2018

If you chose to pay your 2017 property taxes in installments, the second installment is due to and payable to the Walworth County Treasurer by **July 31, 2018**. The installment amounts are shown at the bottom of your tax bill. Please note that the Village cannot accept second installments at Village Hall.
