Partisan Primary Election to be held on August 14, 2018

The Partisan Primary Election will be held on August 14, 2018. Contests on the ballot include primaries for Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State, State Treasurer, United States Senator, Representative in Congress – District 1, State Senator – District 11, Representative to the Assembly – District 31, County Sheriff, and County Clerk of Circuit Court.

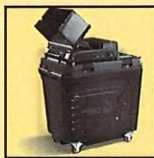


This is a Partisan Primary, which means that voters must choose one party and vote for individual candidates within that party. The Parties on the ballot include Republican, Democratic, Libertarian, Wisconsin Green, and Constitution.

Village residents will vote at Village Hall in the Board Room, and the polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Remember to bring your photo identification card to vote. New Village residents or those who have changed their name or moved since the last election may register to vote on Election Day and will need to bring a valid form of proof of residence to do so. If you have questions about photo identification or proof of residence, please contact Village Hall.

Voters who cannot make it to Village Hall on Election Day may vote by absentee ballot or may request that a ballot be mailed to them. In-person absentee voting will take place from Monday, July 30th through Friday, August 10th from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at Village Hall.

Walworth County has purchased new voting equipment for all municipalities that will be used for the August 14th Election. The ImageCast Evolution or ICE is an optical scan tabulator and ballot marking device in one machine. Voters will place completed ballots in the tabulator as before; however, the ICE will provide additional information for voters relating to voting errors on the ballot (such as cross over votes or over votes). If you have questions or would like additional information, please contact Village Hall.

Updates from July 16th Village Board Meeting

Resolution No. 2018-05: The Village Board approved a resolution authorizing a Conditional Use Permit for a gas station and convenience store (Darien Food Market) to be located at 101 W. Beloit Street on the southwest corner of the intersection of Beloit Street and Walworth Street. The Plan Commission will next review building and site plans when they are submitted.

Resolution No. 2018-06: The Village Board approved a resolution authorizing a Conditional Use Permit for a Community Information Sign to be located in West Park. The new electronic message center will replace the existing letter board sign at the wishing well along Walworth Street in West Park. The sign will be donated by the Darien Community Club and be operated by the Village. **Thank you to the Darien Community Club for your generous donation!!**
